**USGA RULES WILL GOVERN ALL PLAY ALONG WITH THE
FOLLOWING RULES:**

Format: 4-Person Scramble (Captain's Choice)

- Each group should select a team Captain prior to teeing off.
- Each person will tee off from the designated tee and select the best shot. The Team Captain should decide which drive is the most desirable.
- All players then play their next shot from the position of the selected ball. This process is continued until the ball is holed, remember - no gimees, no Mulligans!
- On the putting green each person is given a shot at their first putt. Do not hole out a short putt if you missed your first putt. Once the ball is holed no further shots will count for the team's score.
- The first ball in must count. Mark your ball and wait until all attempts are complete.
- If the ball is on the green, every player will putt from a point within six inches of the ball/no closer to the hole.
- If ball is not on the green, every player hits their next shot within one club length of the ball selected, no closer to the hole.
- If the ball that is selected is in the rough, bunker, or hazard, it must remain in the same condition.
- You may not move the ball from the rough to the fairway.
- Each player on the team must contribute at least **three** drives on either a par-3, par-4 or par-5 hole.
- Record the Team's score.....mark down who drove the ball for each hole on the score card.
- For the **Longest drive** contest, the ball must remain in the fairway. Will not count if in the rough or hazard.
- For the **Closes to the Pin**, par is not required to win.

Tees: Men.....Yellow (Friendly Tees) 85 years old and older
Green Tees - 78-84 years old
White Tees - 60-77 years old

Ladies....Yellow (Friendly Tees) 75 years old and older
Green Tees - 60-74 years old

Turn in scorecards to **Glenn Childs** after play. In the outdoor area at Palmer.
Last foursome please collect and bring in all hole prize markers as you finish play.

Individual Cash Prizes.....All players are eligible. Players can only win one longest drive and one closest to the pin.

Closest to the pin on par 3, your tee shot must be on the green. There will be a tape measure on each green to measure distances. Measure feet and inches please.
Longest drives must be in the fairway.

Team Cash Prizes.....All teams are eligible

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th place cash prizes...depends on number of golfers participating. The prestigious Bonny brook Cup (perpetual trophy) to the first-place winning team.

Tie Breaker Rules:

1st tie break – Last Nine Holes (10-18) Aggregate

2nd tie break – Last Six Holes (13-18) Aggregate

3rd tie break – Last Three holes (16-18) Aggregate

4th tie break – Last Hole (18)
